Transfer Articulation Partnership Agreement

The following transfer articulation partnership agreement serves to provide approved articulation pathways for Marine Trades Institute (MTI) students to transfer MTI coursework as accepted as general elective credits towards either the North Central Michigan College (NCMC) Associate of General Studies (AGS) degree with or without the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) required coursework embedded in the NCMC required credits. The significant difference between these two options is the AGS degree with MTA required coursework provides a greater assurance all NCMC coursework would transfer. Students should contact the NCMC Advising Office, if necessary, for assistance in making this decision.

Both institutions recognize the importance of and value the career and technical education and training offered at industry schools such as MTI. Trades school education and training such as this is often transferred to community colleges for credit towards degrees and certificates. This opportunity provides students the ability to earn a college degree, often leading to greater work productivity and professional advancement.


NCMC and MTI enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

This Transfer Articulation Partnership Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing by both parties. The Agreement will be automatically renewed each July 1st, unless either party notifies the other at least 60 days prior to July 1st that it does not wish to renew said agreement. It is also agreed that MTI will maintain accreditation through the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC) or similar accrediting body recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
